CADETSHIP AWARD - Summer Vacation work 2005/2006

The aim of the Cadetship Award is to provide paid work experience and financial support during the honours year to outstanding students from Australian universities.

To apply for a Cadetship, students must be in their third year of study (or equivalent if undertaking a double degree) majoring in economics or finance and intending to complete honours in 2006.

Initially we offer eight weeks' work experience during the summer vacation commencing early December 2005. For most of the work placement cadets will work on one or two projects culminating in the writing and presentation of a seminar paper. There will also be an opportunity for cadets to participate in a range of development opportunities including discussion sessions run by senior economists and analysts and training in a number of essential software packages.

At the completion of the work experience period the Bank will make a decision whether to offer individual cadets a place on our Graduate Development Program in 2007.

Cadets who are offered and accept a graduate placement will receive on-going financial support for the duration of their honours year in 2006.
