B APPLIED FINANCE WITH B COMMERCE — ACCOUNTING (PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTING)

This is a suggested sequence of units which may guide you in planning your academic program for 2009. It is your responsibility to check prerequisites and ensure that your program satisfies the University requirements for the award of a Bachelor of Commerce — Accounting with the degree of Bachelor of Applied Finance as set out in the 2009 Handbook.

Students transferring to Macquarie University who wish to have qualifications obtained at other tertiary institutions considered for accreditation by the professional accounting bodies (CPA Australia, ICAA and NIA) are reminded that it is the student's responsibility to ensure that these qualifications are accepted by the professional bodies.

With effect from January 2005 CPA Australia has set a limit on two conceded passes (PCs) in a three year Bachelor degree. Additional limits apply to conceded passes in core accounting and business units.

NOTE: To qualify for the degree of Bachelor of Applied Finance with the degree of Bachelor of Commerce — Accounting a candidate must obtain an aggregate of at least 96 credit points which must include: (a) at least 66 credit points in units above 100 level; (b) at least 30 credit points in units above 200 level; and (c) meet the other specific requirements for these degrees as listed in the 2009 online Undergraduate Handbook.
